





Comparative Politics 101: Ethnic Diversity and Development


- Competing preferences
- Collective action problems (weak sanctioning and accountability)
- Weak national identification → limits redistribution, sacrifice accommodation and cooperation (Campbell and Hall; Gellner)

What are some limitations of descent based definitions of ethnicity in the study of politics?

- When does ancestry stop (Great-grandparents)??
- Not all descent-based ethnic identities matter for politics.
- Structure > Agency

- Nominal: Ethnic categories in which an individual is eligible for membership based on the attributes that she or he possesses.
- Activated: Ethnic categories in which she or he professes membership or to which she or he is assigned by others as a member.

"All individuals have a repertoire of nominal ethnic identity categories.....The ethnic identity that an individual actually activates is chosen from this repertoire (p.520)."

Why is the distinction between nominal and activated ethnic identities important for the study of ethnic politics?

- Many cross-national datasets that measure ethnic diversity do not distinguish between nominal vs. activated
 - Ethnic Fractionalization Index: the probability that two randomly drawn individuals are not from the same ethnic group.

- Many cross-national datasets that measure ethnic diversity do not distinguish between nominal vs. activated
 - Which ethnic identities to choose?
 - What if ethnic identities overlap (Black and Hispanic)?
 - What if ethnic identities change over time?

Consociational Democracy (Ljiphart)

- Power-sharing arrangements among ethnic groups
- Inclusion > Majoritarianism
- Clear and formal distinctions across groups
- Elites must transcend cleavages (multi-ethnic elite cartels committed to the state)




